INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- BEFORE INSTALLING CHECK SCHEMATIC OF THE EXHAUST SYSTEM!
- IF ANY ITEMS IN THE AKRAPOVIC EXHAUST SYSTEM PACKAGE ARE MISSING PLEASE CONTACT YOUR AUTHORIZED DEALER. KEEP THE SCHEMATIC FOR FUTURE REFERENCE.
- ! THESE INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS MUST BE READ CAREFULLY IN ORDER TO ENSURE PROPER INSTALLATION AND OPERATION OF THE AKRAPOVIC EXHAUST SYSTEM.
- ! THE EXHAUST SYSTEM CAN BE EXTREMELY HOT. ALLOW THE MOTORCYCLE TO COOL DOWN BEFORE BEGINNING INSTALLATION.

REMOVAL OF STOCK EXHAUST SYSTEM

- 1. put the motorcycle on a side stand, we recommend a racing stand
- 2. remove the lower and the middle parts of the cowling (Figure 1, 2, 3, 4, 5)
- 3. unscrew the bolt for the metal clamp at the muffler/link pipe collector joint (Figure 6)
- 4. unscrew and remove the bolt for the muffler/link pipe bracket (Figure 7)
- 5. remove the muffler/link pipe (Figure 8)
- 6. remove the metal inner sleeve of the rubber damper from the muffler/link pipe hanging bracket (Figure 9)
- 7. remove the right passengers footpeg bracket (Figure 10, 11)

INSTALLATION OF THE AKRAPOVIC SLIP-ON EXHAUST SYSTEM

installing the independent link pipe:

- 1. correctly position and assemble additional carbon-fiber bracket and fitting parts with the stock passengers footpeg bracket. Attach the set onto the frame. (Figure 12, 13)
- 2. coat the bolt and interior side of the metal clamp with Akrapovic anti-seize lead-free copper paste (black tube) and correctly install the metal clamp onto the link pipe (Figure 14, 15)
- 3. slide the link pipe onto the stock collector and correctly attach the spring at the link pipe stock collector joint; make sure the link pipe is not touching the frame and other parts (Figure 16, 17, 18)
- 4. tighten the bolt of the metal clamp (Figure 19)

installing the independent muffler:

- correctly position the carbon-fiber clamp and slide it onto the muffler bear in mind the left offset of the carbon-fiber clamp viewed from the rear. <u>WARNING</u>: open the clamp to slightly wider than the diameter of the outer sleeve of the muffler – do not scrape it along the muffler outer sleeve! (Figure 20)
- 2. in case of installing the optional catalytic converter: correctly position and install the catalytic converter into the link pipe (exposed edge outside) (Figure 21)
- 3. slide the muffler onto the link pipe and attach the springs (Figure 22, 23)
- 4. tighten the carbon-fiber clamp onto the additional carbon-fiber bracket use the fitting parts supplied in the Akrapovic kit (Figure 24, 25, 26, 27)
- 5. make sure that muffler is not touching any other parts of the motorcycle

final installation:

- 1. tighten the bolts on all of the brackets and clamps to which the exhaust system is attached
- 2. clean grease spots:
 - a. muffler titanium outer sleeve: use a soft cloth sprayed with a multi-purpose spray lubricant (WD-40 or equivalent)
 - b. muffler carbon-fiber outer sleeve: use a soft dry cloth
 - c. stainless steel link pipe: use a soft cloth sprayed with a contact cleaner, then wipe with a soft dry cloth
 - d. titanium link pipe: use a soft cloth sprayed with a multi-purpose spray lubricant (WD-40 or equivalent)

Cleaning will prevent spots from burning onto the surface. Do not use aggressive chemical cleaners, because they can damage the sticker.

- 3. replace all cowlings in the reverse order from the order in which they were removed (Figure 28, 29)
- 4. position of the installed Akrapovic SLIP-ON system (Figure 30)
- Check the operation of the brakes and suspension. Make sure all the bolts are sufficiently tightened. In case the
 exhaust system touches the cowling or other parts repeat the adjustment of the exhaust system or contact your
 authorized dealer.
 - I IT IS NORMAL IF WHITE SMOKE COMES OUT OF THE MUFFLER ON FIRST OPERATION.
- ! DO NOT STAND BEHIND THE MUFFLER ON FIRST OPERATION.
- DO NOT USE AUTOMOTIVE WHEEL CLEANERS OR ANY CLEANING PRODUCTS WHICH CONTAIN ACIDIC ADDITIVES TO CLEAN AKRAPOVIC EXHAUST SYSTEMS.

MAINTENANCE OF THE AKRAPOVIC EXHAUST SYSTEM

- Clean the titanium muffler outer sleeve with a multi-purpose spray lubricant (WD-40 or equivalent) and carbon fiber outer sleeve with soft and dry cloth. Do not use aggressive chemical cleaners, because they can damage the sticker. A change in the color of the exhaust system is normal due to the high temperatures.
- The wearing out of the muffler silencing material depends on the type of the motor and riding style. Contact your dealer/serviceman if visible changes appear on the muffler outer sleeve or the noise level is increased.
- 3. Periodically make sure all the bolts are sufficiently tight.




