

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How to install

▲ Warning!

It is advisable to have an Öhlins dealer install the shock absorber.

• Note!

When installing, consult your Vehicle Service Manual.

• Note!

Before installing the Öhlins shock absorber clean the vehicle thoroughly.

1

Put the motorcycle on a workstand so that the rear wheel barely touches the ground.

▲ Warning!

Make sure the vehicle is securely supported so that it will not tip.

2

Open the tool box and loosen the rear seat and lift it off.

3

Loosen the cone shaped connection cover of the left silencer bracket and pull it outwards, this makes it easier to reach the neccessary bolts.

4

Loosen and remove the original spring prespanning adjuster located just above the cone shaped cover.

5

Remove the rear wheel. See the motorcycle workshop manual.

6

Loosen first the lower shock absorber bracket, then the upper and take the original shock absorber out downvards.

7

Install the Öhlins shock absorber in the reversed order, first upper attachment then lower, do not tighten yet.

Lower the motorcycle so that the shock absorber is sligthly compressed, before tightening the screws.

8

Tighten the attachment screws according to BMW specification

9

Reinstall all removed parts to the motorcycle.

▲ Warning!

Make sure that all screws are tightened to the correct torque and that nothing fouls or restricts movement of the shock absorber when the suspension is fully compressed or extended.



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
