
Adjustments

Mounting Instructions

Shock Absorber for BMW R1150RS

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How to install

△ Warning!

It is advisable to have an Öhlins dealer install the shock absorber.

When installing, read the Vehicle Service Manual.

Place the motorcycle on a stand so that the rear wheel barely touches the ground. The swing arm must be free, so that the suspension is unloaded.

▲ Warning!

Make sure the vehicle is securely supported so that it will not tip.

Note!

Clean the vehicle thouroughly before installing the Öhlins shock absorber.

Remove the seats, passenger and rider.

3

Loosen and remove the original spring preload adjuster, located on the right side behind the side cover.

Remove the rear wheel.

5

Remove the right front seat bracket.

6

Loosen first the lower shock absorber bracket, then the upper and take the original shock absorber out downvards.

7


Mount the Öhlins shock absorber in reversed order, first the upper attachment the the lower.

• Note!

Lower the motorcycle so that the shock absorber is sligthly compressed, before tightening the screws.

Reinstall all removed parts in the same way as they were before installation of the Öhlins shock absorber.
