

Mounting Instructions

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How to install How to install

▲ Warning!

It is advisable to have an Öhlins dealer install the shock absorber.

When installing, consult your Vehicle Service Manual.

1

Put the motorcycle on a workstand so that the rear wheel barely touches the ground.

▲ Warning!

Make sure the vehicle is securely supported so that it will not tip.

2

Remove the seats and side covers.

3

Remove the mud guard between the shock absorber and the rear wheel.

4

Remove the attachment bolts and remove the original shock absorber.

• Note!

Before installing the Öhlins shock absorber clean the vehicle thoroughly.

5

Install the Öhlins shock absorber, the preload adjuster on the left side of the vehicle. The gas valve towards the rear. Do not tighten yet.

Caution!

Make sure that the ventilation hoses on the right side of the shock absorber are not squeezed when installing the shock absorber. If necessary, put one of them on the left side of the shock absorber and fix it with the tie wraps provided. 6

Reinstall the attachment bolts. Use the M10x55 bolt and nut supplied for the lower bracket.

Note!

Lower the motorcycle so that the shock absorber is sligthly compressed, before tightening the screws.

7

Tighten the attachment bolts to the correct torque according to the Honda specs.


Install the preload adjuster on the left side at the passenger foot peg bracket according to the figure. Use 2 of the tie wraps for the preload adjuster hose.

9

Reinstall the mud guard, seats and side covers. Make sure that all removed parts are reinstalled in the same way as they were before the installation of the Öhlins shock absorber.

Caution!

Make sure that all screws are tightened to the correct torque and that nothing fouls or restricts movement of the shock absorber when the suspension is fully compressed or extended.
