

Reassemble the triangle link and fit the lower bracket of the shock absorber.


Fit the external reservoir to the frame on the left side. Use the provided hose clamps and position the rubber mounts between the reservoir and the frame.



Fit the hydraulic spanner adjustment to the foot rest bracket. Use the bolt provided (M8 x 30). Fix the hose by using tie raps.

<u>11</u>

Mount the side covers and the seat.



NOTE!

Make sure that all bolts are tightened to the correct torque and that nothing fouls the shock absorber when the suspension is being fully compressed or extended. Check with the Service Manual of the motorbike for correct torque.



Mounting instructions

1

Put the motorcycle on a stand so the rear wheel is off the ground. Make sure it's steady and will not fall over. The center stand is excellent if it is rised a few inches.

A WARNING!


- 1. It's advisable to have an Öhlins dealer or other qualified person to fit your shock absorber.
- 2. Instructions in the motorcycle workshop manual are to be followed when changing the shock absorber.
- 3. When working on the motorcycle it must be securely supported to prevent it from falling over.



Loosen first the upper and then the lower shock absorber attachment.

Loosen the triangle link and remove it.

Unlock the seat and remove it. Remove the left and right side covers.

Remove the wheel of the hydraulic preload adjuster.

Remove the shock absorber downwards.

7

Fit the Öhlins shock absorber by positioning it from underneath. Fit the upper bracket.
