
The damping in this EC-Shock absorber is continuously adjusted according to the riding style. Depending on which power mode (Full, Medium, Low) that is selected on the handle bar, the damping is biased towards comfort on "Low" and towards traction and handling on "Full".

How to Install How to Install

▲ Warning!

It is advisable to have an Öhlins dealer install the shock absorber.

When installing, consult your Vehicle Service Manual.

▲ Warning!

Make sure the vehicle is securely supported so that it will not tip.

1

Put the motorcycle on a workstand so that the rear wheel barely touches the ground.

2

Remove the seat and tank.

3

Remove the lower and the upper screws of the original shock absorber.

4

Remove the original shock absorber by lifting it up from the top of the vehicle.

Note!

Before installing the Öhlins shock absorber clean the vehicle thoroughly.

5

Install the Öhlins shock absorber. First, fasten the upper screw, then the lower. Use the original screws, do not tighten yet.

Note!

Lower the motorcycle so that the shock absorber is sligthly compressed, before tightening the screws.

6

Tighten the upper and the lower screws.

7

Install the hydraulic preload adjuster on the inside of the silencer mounting point. Use the original screw and nut. Fasten the hose with the tie-raps (00231-01) provided in this kit.

8

Mount the ECU on the toolkit bag under the passenger seat using its rubber band.

9

Connect the big connector marked "DIAG" to its white counterpart in the standard harness.

▲ Warning!

Do not connect "DIAG" to the black socket.

10

Route the two connectors "RC" and "RR" forward along the left side of the rear subframe towards the shock absorber.

11

Connect the "RC" contact to "C" on the shock absorber (the one closest to the link) and connect the "RR" contact to "R" (the one closest to the spring).

12

Fasten the harness using tie-raps and tie-rap holders provided.

13

Reinstall the tank and seat.

[™] Caution!

Make sure to bend the hose to the hydraulic preload adjuster away from the swing arm.

Note!


Make sure that nothing interferes with the hose and the adjuster when the rear wheel suspension is fully extended/compressed.




