
Adjustments

Mounting Instructions

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How to install

⚠ Warning!

It is advisable to have an Öhlins dealer install the shock absorber.

When installing, read the Vehicle Service Manual.

1

Place the motorcycle on the centerstand so that the rear wheel barely touches the ground. The swing arm must be free, so that the suspension is unloaded.

▲ Warning!

Make sure the vehicle is securely supported so that it will not tip.

Note!

Clean the vehicle thouroughly before installing the Öhlins shock absorber.

Remove the mudguard.

3

Loosen the drop links from the triangle link and let them hang loose.

4

Loosen first the lower shock absorber attachment, then the upper shock absorber attachment, then remove the original shock absorber upwards to the left side of the vehicle.

5

Install the Öhlins shock absorber in reversed order, do not tighten the screw.

Note!

Lower the motorcycle so that the shock absorber is sligthly compressed, before tightening the screws.

11

Reinstall all removed parts in the same way as they were before installation of the Öhlins shock absorber.

Caution!

Make sure that all screws are tightened to the correct torque and that nothing fouls or restricts movement of the shock absorber when the suspension is being fully compressed or extended.
