

How to install How to install

▲ Warning!

It is advisable to have an Öhlins dealer install the product.

When installing, consult your Vehicle Service Manual.

1

Put the motorcycle on a workstand so that the rear wheel barely touches the ground.

▲ Warning!

Make sure the vehicle is securely supported so that it will not tip.

2

Remove the mounting screws for the standard pre-load adjuster and open the hose clips.

3

Loosen upper and lower attachment of the original shock absorber and remove it.

Note!

Before installing the Öhlins product, clean the vehicle thoroughly.

4

Install the Öhlins shock absorber from the right side.

• Note!

Lower the motorcycle so that the shock absorber is sligthly compressed, before tightening the screws.

5

Tighten the mounting screws and fit the pre-load adjuster in the same position as the standard version.

Use the supplied screws.


Use the tie wrap and/or the standard clips to position the hose.

(b) Caution!

Ensure that the hydraulic preload adjuster hose runs in soft bends. Also check that it does not come in contact with the exhaust pipe or Any sharp edges.

[™] Caution!

Make sure that all screws are tightened to the correct torque and that nothing fouls or restricts movement of the shock absorber when the suspension is fully compressed or extended.
