How to install

Warning!

It is advisable to have an Öhlins dealer install the shock absorber.

When installing, consult your Vehicle Service Manual.

Put the motorcycle on a workstand so that the rear wheel barely touches the ground.

Warning!

Make sure the vehicle is securely supported so that it will not tip.

2

Loosen the push rod from the rear swing arm.

3

Loosen the lower shock absorber mounting bolt.

4

Remove the upper shock absorber mounting bolt and remove the original shock absorber.

Note!

Before installing the Öhlins shock absorber clean the vehicle thoroughly.

5

Install the Öhlins shock absorber in reversed order, do not tighten the fitting bolts yet.

ONOTE!

6

Lower the motorcycle so that the shock absorber is sligthly compressed, before tightening the fitting bolts.

Tighten the upper and lower bolts.

Make sure that all removed parts are reinstalled in the same way as they were before the installation of the Öhlins shock absorber.

🖱 Caution!

Make sure that all bolts are tightened to the correct torque and that nothing fouls or restricts movement of the shock absorber when the suspension is fully compressed or extended.
