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

#### **Mounting instructions**

Put the motorcycle on a stand so the rear wheel is off the ground. Make sure it's steady and will not fall over. The center stand is excellent if it is rised a few inches.

#### **A** WARNING!

- 1. It's advisable to have an Öhlins dealer or other qualified person to fit your shock absorber.
- 2. Instructions in the motorcycle workshop manual are to be followed when changing the shock absorber.
- 3. When working on the motorcycle it must be securely supported to prevent it from falling over.

Remove the small side covers of the motorcycle.

Remove upper and lower shock absorber mounting bolts.

Remove the triangle linkage including the two pullrods.

Remove the chock absorber downwards.



Fit the Öhlins shock absorber from the lower side of the swing. Fit the upper bracket.

Reassemble the triangle link and fit the lower shock absorber bracket.

Make sure that all bolts are tightened to the correct torque and that nothing fouls the shock absorber when the suspension is being fully compressed or extended. Check with the Service Manual of the motorbike for correct torque.
